Part 1

Membership

Members are institutions, organisations or leaders who seek to promote the purpose of the Network.

Institutions* can include:

- Commissioners and Ombudspersons for Future Generations
- Parliamentary Committees
- Government entities

* Institutions can be international, national and or subnational

Organisations can include:

- Think tanks
- Academia
- Non-Governmental Organisations and campaign groups

Leaders can include:

- Individuals who have held leadership roles which align with the Network's purpose.
- Individuals who hold leadership roles which align with the Network's purpose
- Young people who have demonstrated leadership in areas of governance and international decision-making

Each institution/organisation will be represented by one member. Other colleagues may attend as observers with prior consent of the Chair.

Those who wish to join the Network must inform the Network Secretariat and complete a membership form.

As a member you will attend quarterly meetings of the Network and other strategic meetings as required.



Application

- Organisations and individuals who wish to join the Network must complete this membership form.
- The Chair and Deputy Chair will consider membership applications and make recommendations to the Membership.
- Unless more than half of the membership objects in writing, recommendations will be accepted.
- There is no fee for joining the Network.
- Members who wish to leave the Network must inform the Secretariat in writing.

Appeals

- Declined membership can be appealed within 30 days of notice to the Network Secretariat.
- An Appeals Committee will be formed of 25% of the Network Members.
- The Appeals Committee will be chaired by the Network Secretariat.
- The Chair will also have full membership of the Appeals Committee
- A decision of the Appeals Committee must be by majority

The Network Secretariat will notify you of the outcome of this membership application.
